To the Secretariat on Environmental Enforcement Matters of the United States – Peru Trade Promotion Agreement.



🤾 Background:

The Trade Promotion Agreement (TPA), also known as the Free Trade Agreement (FTA), was signed in 2006 and began operating in 2009. The Secretariat was created with this international treaty, in the Environment Chapter (Chapter 18).



What is the Secretariat?

The Secretariat is a mechanism for citizen participation on environmental matters. It receives and processes submissions from people or organizations regarding compliance with environmental laws. The Secretariat depends on the TPA Environmental Affairs Council.

What is the Environmental Affairs Council and what tasks do they have?

The Council is made up of 2 representatives from Peru and 2 representatives from the United States and is responsible for ensuring compliance with the Environment Chapter of the TP Δ

Who can file a Submission?

Any person or entity from Peru or the United States may file a Submission with the Secretariat.

What is a Submission for Environmental Enforcement?

It is a document that indicates that environmental law, whether in Peru or the United States, is not being properly applied. No payment is required to file a Submission and no attorney signature is required. It must include evidence and either Government must be informed before the Submission is filed.



When is a Submission accepted for processing?

The Submission is accepted to be processed if it is written in English or Spanish; identifies that the submitter is a person or entity from one of the 2 countries; indicates the environmental law that is purportedly not being complied with; and identifies that the Submission promotes environmental enforcement.



Submissions Process:

Filing:

The Submission is filed with the Secretariat.

Analysis:

The Secretariat analyzes whether it is appropriate to process the Submission.

Government Response:

The Secretariat defines whether it is appropriate to ask the Government for a response or whether it is appropriate to close the file on the Submission.

Factual Record:

The Secretariat, if applicable, proposes to the Council that a Factual Record be prepared.



Public Access:

The Council may decide that a Factual Record be made public.

Factual Record

What is it?

It is an objective and comprehensive analysis carried out by the Secretariat on information relevant to the subject matter of the Submission. The Environmental Affairs Council may make recommendations to the Environmental Cooperation Commission on matters related to the Factual Record including recommendations to monitor compliance with environmental law.

What is it not?

It is not a court, nor does it impose sanctions. It does not establish responsibilities in any of the countries nor does it provide for the payment of compensation for environmental damage.
